

International Organization (IO) Internship Guide

PURPOSE OF THIS FORM

This form is for the use of F-1 students who are offered off-campus employment under the sponsorship of a <u>qualifying</u> <u>International Organization (IO)</u>, which involves a three-step process:

- 1. You must submit an <u>I-20 Change Request</u> for IO Internship to request a new I-20 with DSO recommendation for off-campus employment authorization.
- 2. You must file the <u>I-765</u> online with the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) within 30 days of the date the new I-20 was issued.
- 3. USCIS must approve and issue an Employment Authorization Document (EAD) card before you can start the internship.

Internship must be completed **prior** to degree completion, it is not available for post-degree authorization (i.e., post-OPT).

Program Criteria & Guidelines

To qualify for an IO employment authorization, you must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Be a full-time F-1 student maintaining status and in a degree program at a SEVP-certified school.
- 2. Have an IO letter of certification that proposed internship is within the scope of its sponsorship.
- 3. You cannot work more than 20 hours per week while school is in session, and may only work full time during annual vacation periods (when school is not in session)
- 4. Internship cannot interfere in normal progress towards degree completion.
- 5. Approvals can be for up to one-year intervals only, if job offer is extended, you must apply for a continuance of authorization six or more months before authorization expires.

How to Apply

Submit the following to ISS:

- I-20 Change Request for an International Organization Internship
- Signed internship letter certifying employment is within the scope of organization's sponsorship; letter must include:
 - Employer's address/location
 - Start and end dates of employment
 - Verify you will work no more than 20 hours per week
 - Supervisor's name, phone number, and email
 - Provide a summary of duties to be performed

Submit IO internship letter and new I-20 along with the following items when filing online <u>I-765</u> with USCIS:

- Enter: code: (c)(3)(ii) on item# 20 of application
- Pay \$410 <u>filing fee</u> (see <u>USCIS website</u> regarding fee waiver criteria)
- Copy of F-1 Visa
- Copy of Valid Passport ID Page
- Copy of I-94
- Copy of any previous EAD cards (if applicable)
